- 3. All vehicle engines must be sealed. Daylight and Engine Seal paperwork must be attached to your log book and presented at scrutineering.
- 4. All nominations received after Thursday 8th December 2016, will be classed as late nominations and will be required to pay a late nomination fee of \$515.00 (inclusive of GST).
- 5. Late nominations will not be received after the closure of scrutineering.
- 6. Nominations fees, once received, will not be refunded.
- 7. All tow and bonus money will be paid no sooner than 21 days after the event (barring any appeals). No money will be paid at the track.
- 8. All hired transponders *must* be returned at the end of the event.
